
About Us

What is involved?

Being a member of Sanctuary Speakers is a unique opportunity for speakers to use their experience to raise awareness of asylum issues with service providers and other City of Sanctuary supporters.

Speakers will be recruited on a rolling basis.

Speakers will be trained and supported to deliver talks with confidence.
